Two types of partnerships

Premium partner

Network partner

A network partnership is essentially a 'friend of HSD partnership'. You contribute a partnership fee to help us fund our mission and in exchange, you can share our logo on your website, post job openings on our talent website and can share news and expertise like blogs and podcasts.
